
AVA Referee Gestures


1) Referees must wear an orange wrist band on their right arm which corresponds with the fighter on the top of the scoreboard.

The ref must make sure the fighter on the top of the scoreboard starts and ends the matches on their right side so the scorekeeper always knows who to select as the winner.



2) The referees must start the match with a downward hand signal while commanding the word `Fight!'.

The referee must also signal and command the word 'Stop!' to stop the match.



3) The referee must raise their arms crossed when a fighter is disqualified before raising the winner's arm

4) In the Overtime rounds, the referee must approve the Back control position then count down (three, two, one, fight!) with a predictable rhythm to start the fight.
